ORGANISATIONAL CONTEXT



Bendigo & District Aboriginal Cooperative (BDAC) is an ACCO (Aboriginal Community Controlled Organisation) registered as a member under the umbrella of VACCHO (Victorian Aboriginal

Community Controlled Health Organisation) and represented nationally through



NACCHO (National Aboriginal Community Controlled Health Organisation).

BDAC was founded to represent and provide services to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people living on Djaara Country.

BDAC has a responsibility to ensure growth of services, development of our Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander community, better and improved health outcomes for our people, improved quality of life and be a lead agency in providing self-determination employment and career pathways for Aboriginal people

LOCAL WORK ENVIRONMENT

Bendigo and District Aboriginal Co-operative provides a range of specialist services for Community living on Djaara Country including a Medical Clinic, Health and Wellbeing, Family and Community Services, and Kindergarten.

POSITION OBJECTIVE

The Culture Care Connect Program will bring together key streams of suicide prevention planning, coordination, and activity across the region. This includes raising awareness, early intervention, crisis management, and aftercare services to support the local Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Community.

This integration of suicide prevention planning and aftercare services enables an Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander-led, coordinated approach to reduce the prevalence of self-harm, suicide ideation and suicide in a way that meets the needs and priorities of the local Community.



The Culture Care Connect Worker will provide aftercare services to Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander Community members who have been referred following a suicide attempt or suicidal crisis in line with agreed service delivery model.

Working within the Culture Care Connect program, they will build and maintain strong referral pathways and will provide care and support to individuals as their case manager for this program.

- Ability to work independently and as part of a team.
- Knowledge of suicide prevention and after care methodologies or strategies.
- Ability to communicate effectively with clients and stakeholders.
- Ability to advocate on behalf of clients / patients.
- Demonstrated ability to build effectively relationships with internal and external stakeholders and service providers.

Desired Education, Training and/or Competencies

• Qualification or experience working in Mental Health, Wellbeing and Suicide Prevention.

CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT

- Must pass a Criminal Police Record Check.
- Must pass and provide copy of Working with Children's Check (or Teachers Registration if applicable).
- Must hold current full Victorian Drivers Licence and provide a copy.
- Must have the right to work in Australia.
- Must pass an Employment History check; and
- Must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 and provide proof.
- Must have and maintain a commitment to child safety, equity, inclusion, and cultural safety.
